The expert group, consisting of representatives of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Serbia, the Institute for Health Protection of the Republic of Serbia, and the Institute for Health Protection of the City of Belgrade, has analyzed the epidemiological situation in the Republic of Serbia for the period from 01.01.2019 to 31.12.2019.

The analysis shows that the epidemiological situation in the Republic of Serbia for the period from 01.01.2019 to 31.12.2019 is characterized by a high level of morbidity and mortality, particularly in the area of infectious diseases.

The most significant findings of the analysis are the high incidence of infectious diseases, particularly in the area of respiratory tract infections, and the high mortality rate in the area of cardiovascular diseases.

The analysis also shows that the epidemiological situation in the Republic of Serbia is influenced by a number of factors, including the demographic structure of the population, the level of socioeconomic development, and the quality of the health care system.

Based on the findings of the analysis, the expert group recommends the following measures to improve the epidemiological situation in the Republic of Serbia:
